SFScon 2019 Call4Speakers

The official **Call for Speakers** for the Free Software Conference 2019, to be held **November 15th, 2019** at **NOI Techpark** in Bolzano/Bozen, Italy, is now open.

The SFScon is an annual conference dedicated to **Free Software** in South Tyrol that is aimed in particular at developers, coders and other talents, but also at the general public and decision makers in business and in public administration. SFScon promotes the use of Free Software in IT infrastructures as a tool to achieve greater innovation and competitiveness.

Through the Call for Speakers, the Conference Committee will accept speaker submissions for possible inclusion in the program.

The proposals should be for **lightning talks** of **15 minutes** including Q&A.

Submissions must include:

- › presentation title
- › informative talk abstract (min. 350 characters)
- › contact information (only for organization purpose)
- › description of the relevance to Free Software & Open Technologies
- › speaker's bio (min. 350 characters): speaker's nationality, company/organization and role
- › squared picture (600×600 pixel) for the speakers' section (www.sfscon.it/speakers)

Additional info (not mandatory):

- › speaker's website and/or social link (Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn)

All information must be provided in English.
