






A world of linked pages published as websites





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








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

Mastodon instance 2










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

## What's new here, architecturally?

#### An internet-wide identity

- · Created in one place (@alice@example.com) but used everywhere
  - · "Oh, this post is by @alice@example.com! I didn't expect her on i-like-furries.example!"
- · Needs some improvements
  - · Make identifier @example.com separable from the actual identity
  - · Need single-sign-on with that identity everywhere



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- Any website can get updates from any other, no IT project required
- Rich, extensible vocabulary of nouns and verbs



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#### Access to the user's social graph

• Can find your friends on other sites!



## Web + Fediverse = Open Social Web

#### Universal account for the web

- · No more new user handles to remember
- · No more separate passwords to reset
- · No more separate profiles to keep updated



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- · E.g. e-commerce: the feed of your purchases flows directly into your personal record keeping website
- E.g. health: the feed of your doctor's visits, prescriptions, lab results etc flows directly into your personal health record and to any other doctor who you'd like to see it
- E.g. software development: all events (commits, changes to bugs, design changes...) you are interested in can end up in a single feed, from where you can engage / comment / like



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- Your friends are always with you, regardless where you are on the web.
  - E.g. e-commerce: see reviews from your friends first



## Some questions to ponder

#### • As a user, what if I could:

- · ...use the same identity across the entire web?
- · ...subscribe to anything that happens on any website and get the feeds where I want them?
- ...find my friends on any website I visit?



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- · ...publish our content to be discoverable all over the web?
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- As a builder / innovator / entrepreneur, what valuable thing can I build now that could not be done before?
